



2015 Chateau Rêva 'Harmony' Rosé

New producer from an esteemed Rosé wine region!

There is a long story behind the walls of this wine estate, created more than 80 years ago, with the estate covering 30 hectares. With new ownership, the name was changed to Chateau Rêva. The diversity of the property is exhibited in that there are 7 different varietals planted on the estate.

Region: Provence

Grape variety:

40% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 7% Semillon, 3% Rolle

Alcohol: 13% by Vol.

Production technique:

The grapes for these wines are hand-harvested and fully handmade. The emphasis of Cinsault as the main grape in the blend brings a spicier, dry structure to the Rosé.

Characteristics: Pale salmon, as to be expected from Provence, with the grip and texture that come from having a high amount of Cinsault in the blend.

Suggestions: Excellent with sunny afternoons by the water, pool, docks living your best life. Pairs well with cured salmon, salmon sashimi, seared tuna, even grilled zucchini or steak tartare.

Ideal serving temperature: 12° C
