



Domaine du Dragon, 'Les Restanques'

New product! French Vermentino!

A grape we associate with Southern Italy in South of France! This is a Rolle aka Vermentino from our top notch Rosé producer in Cotes de Provence region.

In nearby Châteaudouble, witnesses in medieval times reported an epic battle between St. Hermentaire, protector of the city of Draguignan, and a dragon terrorizing the population in the area.

Region: Cotes de Provence AOP

Grape variety: 100% Rolle (aka Vermentino)

Alcohol: 14%

Production technique: Aged in stainless steel vats for 4 months, 3 weeks on lees. The vines are 25-30 years old on average. The vineyards are 30 km to the ocean with elevation of 350 m. There is no malo-lactic fermentation.

Characteristics: Delicate aromatics with white flowers, white fruit like pears almonds and a hint of honey. Lively, lemony and a dense palate.

Suggestions: Richer grilled fish or seafood, lobster salad, fish in butter or cream sauce, fish tartare, mussels in garlic wine sauce.

Ideal serving temperature: 12° C (55° F).
